Competition venue access

Access to the Competition venue is available during Competition Days only: 23–26 September 2026. Visitors will be required to complete the official visitor registration process before arriving at the venue and comply with all access and security requirements in place at the time of the Event.

Visitor registration

All supporters are responsible for independently registering as visitors for WorldSkills Shanghai 2026 before attending the Competition venue.

The visitor registration system is currently under development and will become available closer to the Event. Once registration opens, visitors will be required to complete the registration process and follow all instructions provided by WorldSkills Shanghai 2026.

Please note:

- Registration as a visitor will be mandatory for access to the Competition venue.
- Supporter booking holders are responsible for completing their own visitor registration.
- Registration requirements, deadlines, and access procedures will be published on the official website once available.
- Visitors should regularly check the website for updates and further information.

Travelling to China

Visa and entry requirements

Each participant is responsible for checking whether they require a visa to enter mainland China. Visa requirements may vary depending on nationality, passport type, country of residence, and length and purpose of stay.

Participants should confirm their visa requirements before making travel arrangements.

Participant responsibility

It is the responsibility of each participant to:

- Obtain the appropriate visa (if required)
- Ensure their passport is valid for international travel
- Meet all entry and immigration requirements for China
- Carry all required travel documentation when travelling

SCITS is not responsible for:

- Visa application outcomes
- Immigration decisions
- Delayed visa processing
- Refused entry into China

No refunds will be provided where a participant is unable to travel due to visa or passport issues.

Supporting documents from SCITS

To assist participants with visa applications, SCITS will provide:

- Proof of accommodation confirmation
- Hotel booking confirmation documents for booked Supporter Travel Service dates

Additional supporting documentation may be provided where reasonably required for travel purposes.

Please note:

- SCITS cannot guarantee visa approval
- Visa issuance remains at the discretion of the relevant Chinese authorities

Travel advice

- Apply for visas as early as possible
- Check passport expiry dates carefully
- Monitor official government travel advice
- Allow sufficient processing time before departure

1. Booking and Payment

1.1 Full payment is required at the time of booking. No booking will be confirmed until full payment has been received and cleared.

1.2 Payment methods: Payment may be made by Alipay, WeChat Pay, bank transfer, or by credit card through the PayPal payment platform. Any bank transfer fees are the responsibility of the customer.

1.3 Travel Service booking opens: 10 June 2026, 12:00 Beijing Time

Travel Service booking closes: 30 July 2026, 12:00 Beijing Time

2. Cancellation, Refund, and Amendment Policy

2.1 Changes

If any Purchaser wishes to modify a booking after 30 July 2026, a written request must be emailed to the Shanghai CITS (SCITS) service team. No change will take effect until expressly approved by SCITS.

2.2 Cancellation

After acceptance of the cancellation by SCITS, the Purchaser shall receive confirmation of cancellation by email.

Cancellation policy:

- Cancellation before 30 July 2026: 100% refund
- Cancellation between 31 July and 30 August 2026: 50% refund
- Cancellation after 31 August 2026: No refund

2.3 Substituting Participants in a booking

The Purchaser may replace any registered Participant with another Participant for the same booking type without altering the travel service contents.

All name changes must be completed by 1 September 2026.

2.4 No-Shows

Failure to check in on the arrival date without prior written cancellation will result in no refund and automatic cancellation of the booking.

2.5 Early Departure

No refund is available for unused accommodation nights or shuttle services.

2.6 Invalid Passport or Visa

Each Participant must hold a valid passport and required visa documents when entering China. No refund will be granted where a participant cannot attend due to passport or visa issues.

3. Shuttle Service Terms

3.1 Schedule

Shuttle buses operate on a fixed schedule published approximately 3 days before the Event. Times may change due to traffic or venue requirements.

3.2 Seating

Shuttle seats are not guaranteed if participants miss the scheduled departure time. No refund or alternative transport will be provided.

3.3 Reservation for Shuttle

For shuttle arrangements, participants are required to check the exact departure time at the hotel front desk one day in advance.

3.4 Liability

SCITS is not liable for delays caused by traffic, road closures, accidents, or force majeure circumstances.

4. Modification or Cancellation by SCITS

4.1 If accommodation becomes unavailable due to overbooking, safety concerns, or government direction, SCITS reserves the right to:

- Relocate guests to a comparable or higher-grade hotel at no additional cost, or
- Provide a refund of amounts paid

4.2 SCITS is not liable for consequential damages including travel disruption, visa costs, or lost business opportunities.

5. Limitation of Liability

SCITS accepts no liability for damage, injury, loss, or consequential damages arising from circumstances outside SCITS' reasonable control.

SCITS accepts no liability for schedule changes resulting from:

- Flight delays
- Force majeure
- Government decisions
- Third-party delays

6. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the People's Republic of China.

Any disputes shall first be addressed amicably between parties. Where no resolution is reached, proceedings may be brought before the People's Court with jurisdiction over SCITS.
